

"To recognize himself does not mean to have admiration for himself. It is searching both what he is and what he should be. It is questioning himself about how to think, how to live and how to be happy".



and many prophets have talked to societies to enlighten. In spite of all these, man is still an unselfconscious nameless.



THE UNIIS A BIG BOOK

"The whole unicreated is a letter sent to people and waiting to be read".

According to Islamic scholars, the uniis "the biggest realm". First, let us try to reveal the position of human in this realm, also referred to as the biggest book. Let us make a journey from the universe, the Macro Cosmos, to the Micro Cosmos, i.e. to the cell and the atom.

Our world is a great planet according to most of the other planets in the solar system. All of these planets are spinning around the sun. The world is large, but when compared to the sun it remains very small in size. The proportion of mass between in is about 1.300.000.

Together with our solar system, we are in the Milky Way galaxy. It is said that there are at least 100 billion stars in this galaxy, such as the sun. Their average size is several times of the sun's.

This is also seen in the Micro Cosmos, i.e. in atoms. We are amazed by the existence of such an excellent system from the Macro Cosmos to the Micro Cosmos. Thus, it is understood that the whole universe, including the Micro and Macro Cosmos, is a system of balances.

In this limited but magnificently large size, we may almost seen as "null" in dimension. We don't have information more than this about the universe, but when we look at this frame, our morale is deteriorating and we see ourselves worthless. Yes, why is this weak human in such a large environment to be considered superior to other creatures? What is the reason for our efforts to gain superiority and knowledge in this world, even though we are partially familiar with this idea?
